- Confidence in using IT for planning, assessment, recording progress, and communication.
- A genuine passion for pastoral care, with empathy and sensitivity towards the needs of all children and families.

Head of Sport and Physical Education (Full Time)

**Contract: Permanent**

Location: Dolphin School, Battersea, London

The Head of Sport and Physical Education holds responsibility for all aspects of Sport and PE throughout EYFS to Year 6, and for coordinating provision across the Noah's Ark Nurseries. The role includes teaching PE lessons, coaching school teams, managing fixtures, running clubs and leading a small but dedicated department.

#### **VISION AND LEADERSHIP**

- Provide dynamic, strategic leadership for Sport and PE across the whole school.
- Lead and inspire colleagues in delivering high-quality, engaging lessons and coaching sessions.
- Develop and maintain a comprehensive long-term plan for Sport and PE, working closely with the Headteacher and Senior Team.
- Promote both excellence and participation, ensuring opportunities for all pupils including the most able.
- Coordinate and deliver staff CPD in collaboration with the Senior Team.

#### **CURRICULUM & COACHING**

- Plan, lead and deliver Sport and PE lessons from EYFS to Year 6.
- Ensure high-quality coaching across all sports currently offered (including football, netball, hockey, rugby, cricket, athletics, gymnastics, dance, cross country, capoeira).
- Oversee assessment, reporting and recommendations for sports awards, including preparation for II+ sports scholarships.
- Maintain accurate and up-to-date departmental documentation and policies.
- Offer Sports clubs for a range of year groups each term.

#### **FIXTURES & EVENTS**

- Manage a balanced, competitive and inclusive fixtures programme across all abilities.
- Organise inter-house competitions, Sports Day, tournaments and special events.
- Ensure high standards of sportsmanship, conduct and presentation from pupils and staff.
- Liaise closely with the School Office and other staff to avoid calendar clashes.
- Publish fixtures and results and communicate arrangements clearly to parents and staff.
- Arrange facility hires (e.g., MUGAs, courts) and organise transport for fixtures.
