The role of Class Teacher includes the following duties:

- Ongoing assessment of each pupil
- Thorough knowledge of the curriculum
- Provision of dynamic and well organised lessons
- Planning class visits or visitors
- Systematic behaviour management
- Upholding the school's Christian ethos
- Upholding the school's policies, philosophy and ethos
- Taking part in lunch and break duties involving the whole school
- Providing cover for absent colleagues where necessary
- Liaising with parents in one-to-one meetings and bi-annual Parent-Teacher interviews
- Preparing thorough annual school reports to a high standard
- Attending staff meetings, after-school events and training and preparation days
- Producing attractive displays and maintaining an ordered classroom
- Contributing to the wider life of the school
