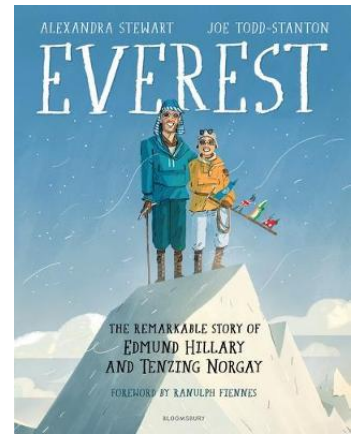
How wonderful to see the incredible creativity that went into producing such a marvellous array of costumes depicting our children's favourite book characters!
